A public hearing, pursuant to Idaho Code § 63-802(1)(e), for consideration of the intent of the Board of Commissioners to include a Forgone Property Tax amount of one hundred thirty thousand ninety-three and No/100 Dollars [\$130,093.00], for the specific purpose to help fund the appropriation for future staffing in the proposed budget for the fiscal year that begins on January 1, 2021 and ends December 31, 2021.

The proposed budget is based on preliminary tax revenue estimates received by the District from the Counties and is subject to adjustment at the public hearing based upon final tax revenue figures which are anticipated to be received from the Counties prior to the budget hearing.
